


ABOUT THE SERIES

TETRIS

Psychologists have discovered that arranging blocks after a difficult experience can reduce intrusive thoughts and distressing images, creating space for the mind to regenerate. Just like clouds drifting across the sky, thoughts come and go in our minds, often uninvited. However, when we quiet the mind, pausing for a moment and staying present in the "here and now," we gain a chance to see reality as it truly is—without the over-interpretations and distortions we tend to create. In this state, all the "blocks" of life start aligning in harmony, as in a game of Tetris. When we are present and calm, we can better see that even what seemed challenging can find its rightful place.

The eyes symbolize the experience of being seen and accepted as we are, reminding us of the profound meaning of presence – both within ourselves and in the world.



PORTAL

This painting was born spontaneously, from an intuitive arrangement of fabric, which was an act of deep immersion in the present moment. The fabric used is a piece of a skirt – a symbol of the conditions we are born into and those that life imposes on us. Yet beneath these layers of conditioning, we remain a blank page – pure, unwritten, and open to what is authentic. The portal invites contemplation of what lies beneath the surface, beyond what is visible and imposed. Initially, the work was meant to be colorful, but ultimately it took on a minimalist form – the creative process ended halfway, leaving space for reflection and simplicity.

GAME CHANGER

This painting invites reflection on our inner world, which we discover by closing our eyes and focusing on ourselves. During meditation, thoughts flow like clouds in the sky, revealing our "inner boxes" – cultural patterns, influences from upbringing, and societal expectations. In everyday life, we often follow something or run from something, much like a character from the 1980s game Pac-Man, wandering through a maze. This painting shows that simply becoming aware of these thoughts and the "game" we are playing allows us to change its rules. We gain freedom and focus on what truly matters

DISCO

"Life is a party, and you are its host. Make it unforgettable."

The artwork expresses the mental programs rooted in our subconscious since childhood, like a scratched record that continuously plays in our minds. These programs shape our thoughts through which we perceive reality – the neverending "disco" in our heads. The ghosts symbolize the emotions that hold us back: fears, anxieties, and worries. The colorful, childlike aesthetic is intentionally used to remind us that most of these subconscious patterns are formed in early childhood. The piece encourages reflection on how childhood experiences influence our adult perception and emotions

UROBOROS

It references the ancient symbol of the serpent eating its own tail – a universal sign of the cyclic nature of life, infinity, and eternal renewal. This symbol serves as a reminder of the unity of beginning and end, the continuous flow of energy, and transformation, which are the essence of existence.

In the context of the exhibition "You Are Not Lost, You Are Here", "Ouroboros" invites reflection on the idea that the moment is both an end and a beginning, and that in this eternal spiral, we can find harmony.

MOON CHILD

The moon rotates around its own axis at the same rate at which it orbits the Earth, which is why its illuminated "near side" is always facing the Earth, while the "far side" remains unseen. Mark Twain wrote, "Everyone is a moon and has a dark side which he never shows to anyone." For alchemists, the task of the adept is to explore this unknown territory of the soul and, if possible, bring it into consciousness.

In the painting, a woman holds a drum that stretches the night sky, with the Vegvisir compass – an ancient talisman of protection and guidance – visible upon it. The Icelandic manuscript Huld assures: "He who possesses the Vegvisir will never lose their way in a storm or bad weather, even if the path is unknown."

Lay flowers at their feet.


Offer them incense, honey, and forgiveness. Honor them and give them your silence. Listen.




HEAVEN BEGINS WITHIN YOU

The spread wings symbolize freedom and readiness to fly. This painting captures the moment when we discover our authentic self and the courage to live life to the fullest



GYE NYAME

Wangari Maathai, the first African woman to be awarded the Nobel Peace Prize for planting trees, began her mission in Kenya, where 90% of the forests had been destroyed. Women, tasked with collecting firewood, had to travel long distances to find branches for cooking. Wangari, aware of the enormity of the problem, started planting trees and later began paying women for each tree they planted, creating the Green Belt Movement. 
